Department of Chamorro Affairs Board of Trustees Meeting Minutes Tuesday, November 19, 2019 – 2pm

I. CALL TO ORDER

There being a quorum, the meeting of the Board of Trustees was called to order at 2:00pm, Tuesday, November 17, 2019 by Chairwoman Linda Reyes.

II. ROLL CALL

Members Present: Linda Reyes, Mary (Shelly) Gibson (via teleconference), Dina Hernandez, Beatrice Limtiaco, Catherine Flores, Leonard Iriarte, and Vicente Meno. Others Present: Anna Marie Arceo (DCA President), Leona Young, Jennifer Paulino, Dominica Tolentino and Koby San Nicolas

III. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairwoman suggested that the minutes be available for all to review before the meeting so that any issues may be brought up immediately and not spend too much time on minutes. Motion to approve minutes for meeting held September 17, 2019, made by Beatrice Limtiaco, seconded by Dina Hernandez. All were in favor and minutes were approved. Chairwoman mentioned that normally the Board Secretary does not prepare the minutes and only attests to it and we will be moving toward that direction where it becomes a function of the department to prepare the minutes.

IV. TREASURER'S REPORT

President Arceo stated that a report was provided but is not updated. Being that DCA does not have an AO, the report was prepared by Sherry Barcinas – CAHA who only comes in intervals and not fulltime. President Arceo will be interviewing this Thursday for an AO. An official Treasurer's report will be provided at the next Board of Trustees meeting. A motion made to table Treasurer's report made by Cathy Flores, seconded by Dina Hernandez. All were in favor and motion was approved.

V. PRESIDENT'S REPORT

A. 2020 Budget

A breakdown was provided and President Arceo reported that without an AO, we got the same amount as last year, however, we lost \$20K for operations. The budget includes the Museum and Chamoru Village.

B. Guam Museum

1. Leona Young reported that the Kosas Advisory Board has been formed and enough for a quorum. First meeting is scheduled for November 20, 2019. Some action items that will be addressed is: the election of officers, setting meeting dates, review museum matters specific to the repository collection contract



operations, review the status of the AG's response to the AAL (fees), review the OPA audit status and review accreditation proposal. Moving forward, the Advisory Board will review all Museum matters and recommend action for DCA to take.

2. The Museum Foundation is doing a partner with the Governor and Lt. Governor's Office to host the Christmas Festivities at the Museum. Schedule of events provided to Board of Trustee Members.

3. Board Member Beatrice Limtiaco inquired about the dehumidifier that was needed at the repository. Leona Young reported that it is still needed and the last few weeks were spent focusing on the mold mitigation, also changing out boxes, airconditioning and changing out the doors. The dehumidifier will come soon. The challenge with not having an AO, Leona Young is having to do the administrative work. SHPO came down to do a site inspection and were satisfied with the organization of the boxes and the labeling.

4. As for the project "I Naftan I manainata", burial of ancestral remains, Mary (Shelly) Gibson has taken the lead on this project and is working with Gary (Office of Economic Adjustment). Target date is first quarter of 2020.

C. CHamoru Village

1. Jennifer Paulino reported as of November 2019 there are currently 10 occupied food units, 4 vacant food units (evicted businesses) and 2 food units with major repairs needed amounting to \$50K each. On the retail side there are 22 units and 1 vacant. Produce there is one. Ms. Paulino also explained that before eviction, there is a due process. Original rules and regulations that have been established is what is being followed and enforced. Board Member Cathy Flores suggested that we revisit the lease agreement and bring it up to date. Ms. Flores will obtain a copy of the lease and have legal look over it. A suggestion was to form a subcommittee to review.

2. Recent programs and projects, is the revision of the Wednesday Night Market SOP. Going through phase 1, 2 & 3. This way, it's a gradual change that the merchants can adapt to. Phase 1 is compliance. Phase 2 (which is where we're at currently) is to start moving people around and scheduling different areas in the village for the different types of categories based on items being sold such as, made on Guam products, products promoting Guam but not made on Guam, and all other vendors.

3. Ms. Paulino reported that they are looking into a program and filling vacant spaces by offering Guam Product Seal holders to perform demonstrations such as making candy and weaving daily and making the space rentals more affordable by dividing the space amongst vendors.

4. CHamoru Village was voted the "Best in the Pacific" winner by visitors from other regions (Japan, Korea, etc..).

5. Incident Reports:

- A&L Variety cited and suspended for non-compliance of selling outside of her shop on Wednesday Night without paying the fee and displaying clothing outside her shop which is a safety hazard.

- Vendor Julia Rivera – a report received that a family member drove off property intoxicated and hit a child. GPD was called. The child was not hurt. The person was picked up and vendor was suspended. With this incident we are looking into increasing security.
- Homeless Issue: There is a great number of homeless people squatting underneath the Festival Huts. Personnel would clean the area but then they come back again. The Homeless Coalition advised that all they can do is go there and warn them.
- Reported today, there are at least 25 – 30 water spigots, each one of them were broken and stolen. It would cost about \$700 to replace all.

6. Wednesday Night Market fees have not changed in so many years. Fees need to be revisited and updated.

7. G4S Contract is up, it's been 5 years. Since then, there has been the addition of the festival huts so plans are to increase security both manpower and security hours. Bid process is ongoing.

8. In regards to the Catholic School bussing, President Arceo met with the Superintendent of Catholic Schools and he arranged for a school aid from each school go out and supervise the kids until they are picked up. The problem is with the students from the Charter School. A suggestion was made to post up warning signs for the students.

9. Upcoming calendar of events for CHamoru Village provided. Entertainment from local dance groups and local bands are scheduled to perform.

10. We're looking into the direction of Jennifer Paulino becoming the General Manager of CHamoru Village. What's still missing is the AA, the CHamoru Village General Manager and Maintenance Supervisor. It was suggested by Vicente Meno that we promote within as we already have qualified people in the system.

A. FestPac

Scheduled from June 10 – 21, 2020 in Hawaii. We will have 100 delegates, in which selection will be announced in January or end of February 2020. Orientations are going on. There are 2 administrators going which is DCA President as Head of Delegation and the Governor or Lt. Governor. Funding will come from the Present of the Arts. To offset some of the cost, they will be doing some fundraisers and get sponsorship.

B. CHamoru Heritage Task Force

Tasked to assess all agencies that are CHamoru serving and CHamoru centric and how to make alliances and collaborate to find commonalities. Deadline is December 1, 2019 to give recommendation to the Governor of findings. It is alliance based and collaboration based with all the entities.

C. Fuetsan CHamoru

This is the Liaison group from every department. 2 liaisons are sent from each department who come to train on orthography.


VI. OLD BUSINESS

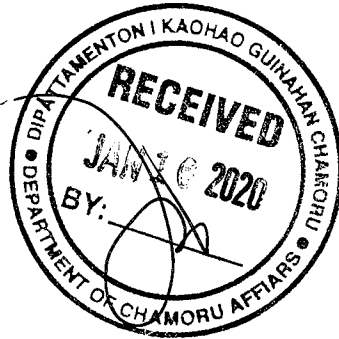




